## Preventing fires can be simple

Fire safety takes knowlege and good maintenance. Does your team know...

- 1. Where fire extinguishers, hoses, alarms, phones, and exits are located?
- 2. Which extinguishing agents to use and how to use them?
- 3. How to sound a fire alarm and obtain fire-fighting assistance?
- 4. Where the designated meeting place is in case of a fire?
- 5. What type of conditions at your work site should be reported?

### Report

- 1. Overheating of materials and equipment.
- 2. Defective electrical equipment, or wiring in poor condition.
- 3. Leaking gas, solvents, oil, gasoline, etc.
- 4. All fire hazards which you cannot correct.
- 5. All sparking, arcing, and fire immediately.

#### Checklist

Is your workplace firesafe?

- 1. Area all areas kept clean and orderly?
- 2. Are aisles, exits, and fire protection equipment free from obstructions?
- 3. Is the trash taken out regularly?
- 4. Are flammable liquids, oily waste, and paint soaked rags stored in approved safety cans?
- 5. Have all heat fuel air combinations been eliminated?
